Ordinance Number: 50

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LOCAL OPTION SALES AND SERVICES TAX APPLICABLE TO TRANSACTIONS WITHIN ALL UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF JASPER COUNTY, IOWA AND WITHIN THE INCORPORATED CITIES OF BAXTER, COLFAX, KELLOGG, LAMBS GROVE, LYNNVILLE, MINGO, MONROE, NEWTON, OAKLAND ACRES, PRAIRIE CITY, REASNOR, SULLY, AND VALERIA, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JASPER COUNTY, IOWA:

Section 1> Local Option Sales and Services Tax.

1a> There is imposed a local option sales and services tax applicable to transactions within all unincorporated areas of Jasper County, Iowa and all incorporated areas of the cities of Baxter, Colfax, Kellogg, Lambs Grove, Lynnville, Mingo, Monroe, Newton, Oakland Acres, Prairie City, Reasnor, Sully and Valeria, (all within Jasper County, Iowa).

1b> The rate of the tax shall be one percent (1.0%) upon the gross receipts taxed under Iowa Code chapter 423, Division IV, and/or Iowa Code chapter 423B (Local Option Tax) within those jurisdictions set forth in foregoing paragraph 1a.

1c> The local option sales and services tax is imposed on all applicable transactions occurring on or after July 1, 2006 within each of the respective jurisdictions set forth in foregoing paragraph 1a. All persons required to collect state gross receipts taxes shall collect the tax pursuant to Iowa Code section 423B.5 for local option sales and services tax.

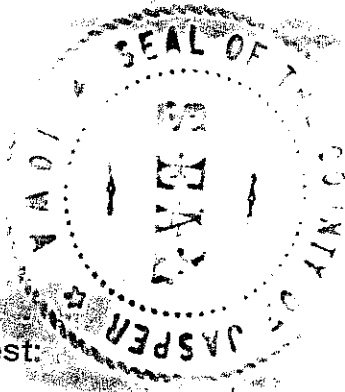
1d> All applicable provisions of the appropriate sections of Iowa Code chapter 423, Division IV, and/or Iowa Code chapter 423B, as such may be from time to time amended, are hereby adopted by reference.

Section 2> Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately following its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Section 3> Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. Termination of such tax or any amendments to the applicability, rate, or use thereof by or relating to any one or more of the jurisdictions set forth in foregoing paragraph 1a shall not affect the validity of this ordinance in relation to any of the other jurisdictions.

Second and third readings of this Ordinance were waived in the manner and otherwise as authorized under the provisions of Iowa Code §331.302, viz. §331.302(5); and, the within and foregoing Ordinance was amended and adopted on the 6th day of June, 2006 upon the following roll call vote.
